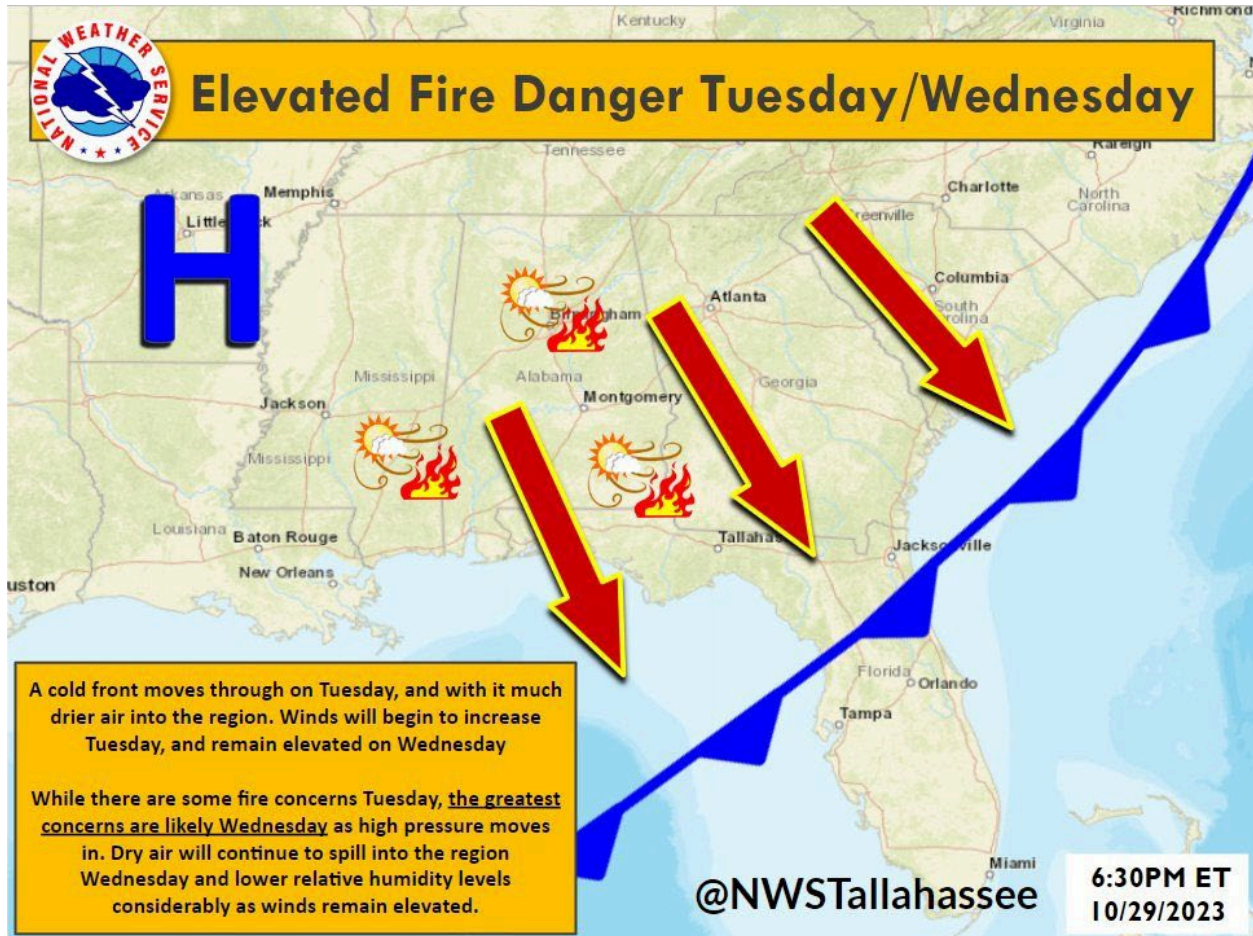




# Public Notice
