The Washington County Board of County Commissioners is currently accepting applications for an **ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER ASSISTANT** position. The primary function of the Animal Control Officer Assistant under general supervision performs protective service work in the field, enforcing laws and ordinances relating to Animal Control. Involves the apprehension and/or responding to complaints of dogs, cats, livestock, wildlife, exotic animals and dealing with the public relation problems that arise in doing so.

Minimum Training and Experience:

- Graduation from a standard high school or equivalent
- Must possess a valid Florida Driver's License
- Experience in animal control and/or maintenance of animals

Special Requirement: Must successfully complete a 40-hour minimum standard training course approved by the Florida Animal Control Association, per Florida Statute, Chapter 828, Section 27, within six (6) months of appointment. This position is subject to weekend work and 24-hour call on a rotational basis.

Note: Must be able to lift up to sixty (60) pounds, walk, run, stand, stoop, bend, push, pull and crawl. Must be able to work outside in heat, cold, daylight, darkness and adverse weather.
