The primary function of this position is to serve as a Spray Truck Driver for Washington County Board of County Commissioners. The individual in this position must communicate with the Mosquito Control Director regularly, have the ability to operate a Spray Truck, and complete necessary paperwork for each shift.

This is a Temporary/Seasonal position primarily working in the evening/night.
