

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR 2020 SUNNY HILLS RESURFACING
SECTION 00015-PROJECT OVERVIEW

The 2020 MSBU Sunny Hills resurfacing includes the resurfacing of 4.13 miles of existing paved roadways that have deteriorated over time and exposed the existing soil cement base in many sections. The contractor will be required to broom all loose material and clip the edges of the road to match the existing roadway width (mostly 20' except on major streets). The locations for starting and stopping paving operations will be marked daily for the contractor by owner's representative. The Project is a Unit Price Bid and the owner may elect to extend the contract to utilize all the funding that is available for the project or may elect to reduce the scope based on overall contract costs. The goal of the owner is to have the resurfaced roadways built with a 2% slope when they are completed. There are some roadways where providing a full 2% crown may not be feasible due to their condition. The engineer of record may elect to reduce the crown to a 1% slope in areas where significant leveling would be required to attain a full 2% slope. The Unit Price for the 165 LB/SY cap should include tack cost as noted in the bid forms. This Unit Price project may include negotiations for additional paving in Sunny Hills if additional funding becomes available and the owner and contractor agree on the scope and cost for the additional work. Since there are no plans for the project we strongly encourage the contractors to visit the project site and evaluate the roadway conditions prior to bidding.

Such attorneys-in-fact, subject to the limitations set forth in their respective powers of attorney, shall have full power to bind the Corporation by their signature and execution of any such instruments and to attach thereto the seal of the Corporation. When so executed, such instruments shall be as binding as if signed by the President and attested to by the Secretary. Any power or authority granted to any representative or attorney-in-fact under the provisions of this article may be revoked at any time by the Board, the Chairman, the President or by the officer or officers granting such power or authority.

ARTICLE XIII - Execution of Contracts: Section 5. Surety Bonds and Undertakings. Any officer of the Company authorized for that purpose in writing by the chairman or the president, and subject to such limitations as the chairman or the president may prescribe, shall appoint such attorneys-in-fact, as may be necessary to act in behalf of the Company to make, execute, seal, acknowledge and deliver as surety any and all undertakings, bonds, recognizances and other surety obligations. Such attorneys-in-fact subject to the limitations set forth in their respective powers of attorney, shall have full power to bind the Company by their signature and execution of any such instruments and to attach thereto the seal of the Company. When so executed such instruments shall be as binding as if signed by the president and attested by the secretary.

Certificate of Designation - The President of the Company, acting pursuant to the Bylaws of the Company, authorizes David M. Carey, Assistant Secretary to appoint such attorneys-in-fact as may be necessary to act on behalf of the Company to make, execute, seal, acknowledge and deliver as surety any and all undertakings, bonds, recognizances and other surety obligations.

Authorization - By unanimous consent of the Company's Board of Directors, the Company consents that facsimile or mechanically reproduced signature of any assistant secretary of the Company, wherever appearing upon a certified copy of any power of attorney issued by the Company in connection with surety bonds, shall be valid and binding upon the Company with the same force and effect as though manually affixed.
